Entrance Requirements

Sisaket College of Agriculture and Technology is happy to receive applications from students from any country.

To apply for certificate level, applicants must have already completed grade 9. To apply for diploma level, candidates must have already completed grade 12 or certificate in agriculture or other equivalent academic qualifications. In order to be admitted, candidates must show evidence of an appropriate educational background and good command of Thai.

Cost of Studying

The tuition fee will be between 2000-3000 baht/semester depending on the course. You have to pay the fee at the beginning of the semester. There are two semesters in one academic year.

Food and accommodation

The college provides on campus accommodation. It is also provides three meals a day, seven days a week in the dining hall. You pay between 1000-1500 baht per month for food. You pay 1000 – 2000 baht per semester for accommodation. College catering is run on a not-for-profit basis. The college caterers work hard to provide balanced meals.
